INTERNATIONAL

1) I2U2 Summit

- I2U2- short for India, Israel, UAE and US- will hold its first virtual Summit next month.
- Earlier, in October 2021, the four countries had foreign ministers meeting under the new framework. It is considered as an outcome of the Abraham Accords that paved the way for collaboration between India, Israel and the United Arab Emirates.

2) LaMDA (Language Models for Dialog Applications)

- Google engineer has believed that LaMDA has become a sentient program.
- LaMDA is a machine-learning language model created by Google as a chatbot that is supposed to mimic humans in conversation.

NATIONAL

1) Jagatguru Sreesant Tukaram Maharaj Shila Mandir

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has inaugurated Jagatguru Sreesant Tukaram Maharaj Shila Mandir at Dehu Village near Pune, dedicated to the 17th-century
- Sant Tukaram was a Warkari saint and poet, famously known for Abhanga devotional poetry and community-oriented worship through spiritual songs known as Kirtans.

2) Bharat Gaurav Train

- Maiden Service of Bharat Gaurav Train commenced under Bharat Gaurav Scheme from Coimbatore North to Sainagar Shirdi.
- Bharat Gaurav Trains are theme-based trains launched by Indian Railways in November 2021.

3) "Way Finding Application"

- Union Cabinet approved an agreement between India and the United Nations on a "Way Finding Application" to be used in the Palais des Nations, United Nations Office at Geneva (UNOG).

- Union Railway Minister, Ashwini Vaishnaw has launched "StartUps for Railways".
- It is an important initiative in the field of innovation.
- It aims at bringing about innovative solutions to problems like rail fracture, reduction of time between two trains and other passenger related issues.

5) Agnipath scheme

- Agnipath is a recruitment scheme for the Indian youth who wish to join the Armed Forces. It aims to strengthen national security and provides an opportunity to youth to serve in armed forces.
- Around 45,000 to 50,000 soldiers, between age of 17.5 to 21 years will be recruited annually.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) KCC Digital Renewal scheme

- Indian Bank launched its KCC Digital Renewal scheme, enabling eligible customers to renew their Kisan Credit Card accounts via digital modes.
- The initiative is part of the bank's digital transformation under project 'WAVE' -World of Advanced Virtual Experience.

2) Banks Board Bureau

Centre is planning to introduce a new entity in place of Banks board Bureau with a wider and more legally tenable mandate.

- BBB is an Autonomous Body of Government of India founded in 2016 based on the P.J. Nayak Committee recommendation to select and appoint Board members for various financial institutions in the public sector.
