1) Scheme for critical care and support for accessing justice to rape gang rape survivors

- Ministry of Women & Child Development, under Nirbhaya Fund, set up a scheme Scheme for critical care and support for accessing justice to rape gang rape survivors and minor girls who get pregnant was appraised at the total cost of Rs.74.10 cr.
- The scheme aims at providing shelter, food & daily needs, safe transportation for attending court hearings and legal aid to the minor girls who have been abandoned by the family due to forced pregnancy, either due to rape/gang rape or due to any other reason, and have no other means to support themselves.

2) Visitor's Conference 2023

- The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu inaugurated Visitor's Conference 2023 at Rashtrapati Bhavan.
- In this conference, President stated that providing equitable and inclusive higher education to youth coming from socially and economically disadvantaged groups is one of the priorities of the National Education Policy- 2020.
