NATIONAL

1) Royal Society of Chemistry and CSIR collaborate

- A initiative to promote chemical sciences in schools and universities is being supported by a partnership between the Royal Society of Chemistry and the Council for Industry and Scientific Research (CSIR).

- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the two organisations states that they will collaborate on the CSIR's Jigyasa programme, an outreach initiative for researchers and schoolchildren that spans all of India.

2) Dairy cooperative conclave

Union Home and Cooperation Minister Amit Shah is set to inaugurate dairy cooperative conclave of the eastern and northeastern zones in Sikkim on October 7.
The conclave is being organised by the National Cooperative Dairy Federation of India.

3) 'SymphoNE' virtual conference

- Union Minister for Tourism & Culture, G. Kishan Reddy has launched the twoday virtual conference 'SymphoNE'.

- The Virtual Conference 'SymphoNE' is being organized on 24th & 27th of September 2022 by the Ministry of Development of the North Eastern Region on the occasion of World Tourism Day.

- The conference will aim to create a roadmap to showcase the unexplored beauty of North East India & boost the tourism Sector in the North Eastern Region.

4) "Sign Learn" smartphone app

- The Center released the "Sign Learn" smartphone app, a 10,000-word lexicon for Indian Sign Language.

- The 10,000-word Indian Sign Language Research And Training Centre (ISLRTC) lexicon serves as the foundation for Sign Learn. All the terms in the ISL dictionary can be searched using Hindi or English on the app, which is accessible in Android and iOS versions.

2) SAANS - portable device

The Assam government has decided to use SAANS, an air pressure machine developed by a Bangalore-based start-up, in the state-run hospitals across the state.
'SAANS' is a portable neonatal Continuous Positive Air Pressure (CPAP) system that can provide lifesaving breathing support to infants in hospital settings as well as during travel.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) Air India Signs Agreement with Willis Lease Finance Corporation

- Air India announced that it has signed a definitive sale and lease back agreement with Nasdaq-listed Willis Lease Finance Corporation for 34 CFM56-5B engines installed on its Airbus A320 family fleet.

- Under the agreement, Willis Lease will purchase 34 engines from Air India, powering 13 Airbus A321 aircraft and four Airbus A320 aircraft.

1) Dadasaheb Phalke award

Veteran actress Asha Parekh has been declared the recipient of the 2020
