INTERNATIONAL

1) Japan and India Signed an MoU:

- The National Institute of Advanced Industrial Science and Technology (AIST), Japan, and the All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) signed a Memorandum of Understanding.
- The MoU aims to increase academic institutions' technical capabilities and capacities.
- The goal is to improve Ayurveda by the use of cutting-edge scientific methods, equipment, and technologies. A joint research effort by the Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi and AIST was carried out even during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- They conducted study into Ashwagandha's effectiveness as a COVID-19 inhibitor. AIST and IIT Hyderabad have previously worked together to conduct artificial intelligence research.

2) US and India launched of a new energy task force

- India and US announced the launch of a new energy task force to support the large-scale integration of renewable energy needed to support the clean energy transition.
- The announcement will strengthen the India-US partnership in the critical energy sector to new levels.
- There was also a bilateral meeting between Union Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas Hardeep Singh Puri and US Energy Secretary Jennifer Granholm, after which the announcement was made.

3) Shanghai Cooperation Organisation

- Pakistan has confirmed that it will attend the Shanghai cooperation organisation's anti-terror exercises in India. Pakistan, which is a part of SCO will take part in counter-terror drills in Haryana's Manesar in October.
- These exercises will be conducted under the ambit of the SCO regional anti-terrorism structure (RATS).

NATIONAL

1) Agni Tattva Campaign

- Agni Tattva campaign to raise awareness under LiFE Lifestyle for the Environment is now being carried out by Power Foundation of India in collaboration with Vijnana Bharati.
- The goal of this campaign, which involves educational institutions, local communities, and pertinent organisations, is to raise awareness of the central idea of Agni Tattva, one of the five elements of Panchmahabhoot and a symbol of energy.

2) Modhera village

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has declared Modhera village in poll-bound Gujarat as the country's first 24×7 solar-powered village. Modhera, which is famous for a centuries-old Sun temple built during the Chalukya, will also be known as a "solar-powered village".
- Modi, who is on a three-day visit to Gujarat, will inaugurate various development projects worth more than ₹14,600 crores.
- Assembly elections in the Bharatiya Janata Party-ruled Gujarat are scheduled to be held by the end of this year.

3) Weapon System Branch For IAF officers

- On the occasion of the 90th anniversary of the Indian Air Force the Centre has approved the creation of a weapon system branch for IAF officers.
- This is the first time since independence that a new operational branch has been created.
- This will essentially be for manning of four specialised streams of Surface to Surface missiles, Surface to Air Missiles, Remotely Piloted Aircraft and Weapon System Operators in twin and multi-crew aircraft.

STATE NEWS

1) Jharkhand and West Bengal topped in worst state list in terms of child marriage

- The latest demographic sample survey by the Union Home Ministry, the survey was brought out by the office of the Registrar General and Census Commissioner, Ministry of Home Affairs.
- It was conducted in 2020 and the report was published late last month.
- The Sample Registration System Statistical Report contains estimates of various demographic, fertility and mortality indicators based on the data collected through one of the largest demographic surveys in the world covering about 8.4 million sample population.

2) Mahakal Lok

- "Mahakal Lok" corridor first phase of Mahakaleshwar Temple in the city of Ujjain in Madhya Pradesh, is scheduled to open by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
- It is said that the initiative will improve pilgrims' experiences and increase tourism in the area. Shivraj Singh Chouhan, the chief minister of Madhya Pradesh, examined the Mahakal Lok's opening preparations.

- Mohammad Rizwan secures his first-ever ICC Men's Player of the Month crown after a remarkable spell of scoring throughout September and sees him overcome fellow nominees Cameron Green (Australia) and Axar Patel (India) to the prize.

2) 37th National Games In October Next year

- The Indian Olympic Association has confirmed that Goa will host the 37th edition of the National Games in October next year.
- The state government of Goa also conveyed its in-principle approval to IOA to host the National Games in 2023. The Goa delegation may receive the IOA flag at the Closing Ceremony of the 36th National Games on 12th October 2022 in Surat, Gujarat.
- The 37th National Games will be decided to keep in view of the dates of the 19th Asian Games, which will be held from 23rd September to 8th October 2022 in Hangzhou, China.

3) Pooja patel Becomes First athlete To win Gold In Yogasana.

- At the 36th National Games, Pooja Patel of Gujarat has become the first athlete to win gold in Yogasana.
- Yogasana is one of the five sports to be played at the National Games this year for the first time. This Indian indigenous sport made its debut at the Khelo India University Games earlier this year.
