1) Azerbaijan launches operation in Karabakh

Azerbaijan launched a military operation against the breakaway Nagorno -Karabakh region.

NATIONAL

1) UNESCO tag for Hoysalas temples

- UNESCO has officially added Karnataka's Sacred Ensembles of Hoysalas to its prestigious World Heritage list.
- The Sacred Ensembles of Hoysalas include renowned temples in Belur, such as the Chennakesava Temple, and Halebid, featuring star-shaped architectural plans and finely detailed sculptures.
- The Chennakesava Temple in Belur was constructed by King Vishnuvardhana of the Hoysala dynasty.
- The Hoysala temples of Belur are located in the Hassan district of Karnataka
- The Hoysala dynasty ruled over Karnataka between the 10th and 14th centuries.

2) "Swavlamban 2023"

- The Indian navy is set to host the 2nd Edition of the Naval Innovation and Indigenisation Seminar, 'Swavlamban 2023,' on October 4-5, 2023.
- The 'Swavlamban 2023' seminar aims to showcase and promote indigenous innovations and technologies developed by startups and MSMEs for use in the Indian Navy.

4) "Udaan Bhawan"

- Union Minister of Civil Aviation and Steel inaugurated 'Udaan Bhawan,' an Integrated Office Complex at Delhi's Safdarjung Airport.
- The complex comprises three above-ground levels and an additional three levels below ground, providing space for 1,270 officials.

5) "Vibhav" Anti tank Mines

- The Indian Army has recently inducted 600 self-neutralizing anti-tank mines, known as "Vibhav".
- Developed indigenously in collaboration with the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), these anti-tank mines are designed to provide mobility kill capability against all types of enemy armored vehicles.

6) Old Parliament Building renamed "Samvidhan Sadan"

- The old Parliament building will now be known as "Samvidhan Sadan". Both Lok Sabha Speaker and Rajya Sabha chairman accepted the proposal made by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
- Designed by British architects Lutyens and Baker, the building served as the Imperial Legislative Council during British rule.

1) The Rashtriya Vigyan Puraskar

- The Union government is set to institute the Rashtriya Vigyan Puraskar 56 prizes to felicitate scientists, technologists and innovators.
- The RVP will comprise three Vigyan Ratna, 25 Vigyan Shri, 25 Vigyan Yuva Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar and three Vigyan Team awards.
