INTERNATIONAL

1) World's Best Universities

- The 20th edition of the World's Best Universities by the Times Higher Education (THE) rankings has been released. The top 10 universities are:
- University of Oxford, followed by Stanford University, and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).
- The Indian Institute of Science (IISc) Bangalore has made history by securing the top position among Indian universities.

2) Earthquake Alerts System

- Google has launched its Earthquake Alerts System for Android smartphone users in India. The system was developed in collaboration with the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) and the National Seismology Center.
- It offers early warnings of seismic activities and is available in multiple Indian languages.

3) World Talent rankings

- The 2023 World Talent Ranking was released by the International Institute for Management Development.
- India's rank: Slipped four spots to the 56th position (Out of 64 economies) compared to its 52nd position in the 2022 ranking.
- In the IMD World Talent Ranking for 2023, Switzerland secured the top position, followed by Luxembourg in second place, and Iceland, Belgium, and the Netherlands rounding out the top five.
