INTERNATIONAL

1) Swaminarayan Akshardham temple

- The Swaminarayan Akshardham temple in Robbinsville Township, New Jersey, is set to be inaugurated on 8th October 2023, under the guidance of its spiritual head, Mahant Swami Maharaj.
- It is to become the second-largest Hindu temple in the world, following the majestic Angkor Wat in Cambodia.

2) 19th edition of YUDH ABHYAS

The 19th edition of YUDH ABHYAS is set to commence in Alaska, USA. The exercise is a collaborative effort between the Indian Army and the US Army, aimed at strengthening military cooperation and readiness.

3) Counter Terrorism Field Training Exercise

- An Indian Army contingent embarked on a journey to Russia to participate in the ASEAN Defence Ministers Meeting Plus Expert Working Group on Counter Terrorism.
- The event known as the Counter Terrorism Field Training Exercise (FTX) 2023, is scheduled to take place from September 25th to September 30th.

NATIONAL

1) Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserve

- The Madhya Pradesh Government has unveiled the Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserve, becoming the seventh tiger reserve in the state and the 54th in India.
- Madhya Pradesh retained the "tiger state" status in the 2022 census with the number of big cats in the state rising to 785 from 526 in 2018.

2) Bharat Drone Shakti-2023

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh is set to inaugurate the Bharat Drone Shakti-2023 exhibition at Hindan Air Base in Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh.
- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh will formally induct the C-295 transport aircraft into the Indian Air Force.

3) Tezu airport

- Union Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya M Scindia inaugurated the newly upgraded Tezu airport in Arunachal Pradesh's Lohit district.
- The capital investment of this project is Rs 170 crore and it spans across a 40,000 square foot area.
- Tezu Airport, initially operationalized in 2018 under the RCS UDAN scheme, has undergone a significant transformation.

4) Multiple entry, Exit option in higher studies may not suit India

- After several organisations of students and teachers raised objections to the op tion of multiple entry and multiple exit (MEME) in the National Education Policy (NEP), the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Education, headed by BJP MP Vivek Thakur, has advised the Centre to hold discussions with all stakeholders.
- The panel, in a report titled "Implementation of the National Education Policy, 2020 in higher education", said Indian institutions were likely to face several issues in implementing this system.
