- According to the survey, a staggering 59% of Indian respondents reported experiencing burnout symptoms.
- Japan ranked at the lowest end of the spectrum with a mere 25% well-being score, while Turkey claimed the top spot with 78%, closely followed by India at 76% and China at 75%.

5) "Women for Water, Water for Women Campaign"

- The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) introduced a groundbreaking initiative called the "Women for Water, Water for Women Campaign". This campaign, known as "Jal Diwali".
- The primary aim of the campaign is to provide a platform for the active participation of women in water governance.

6) Chanakya Defence Dialogue 2023

- The Chanakya Defence Dialogue 2023, a two-day event hosted by the Indian Army in collaboration with the Centre for Land Warfare Studies.
- The Dialogue aims to address security challenges in South Asia and the Indo-Pacific region.

1) Air Quality Index
