INTERNATIONAL

- 1) "Avoid global food shortages"
- Russia and Ukraine have agreed to extend a UN-brokered grain export deal for another 120 days, officials announced.
- World leaders praised the breakthrough for helping "avoid global food shortages" at a crucial time.

2) "Homer"

- The Cambridge Dictionary has revealed its word of the year for 2022 as "homer", saying that it was inspired by the global word game sensation, Wordle.
- The word "homer" was searched for nearly 75,000 times during the first week of May 2022, when it was an answer in the word game Wordle.
- In the context of the game, "homer" doesn't refer to the Greek poet and author, or a character from Simpson, but refers to an informal American English word for a 'home run' in baseball.



NATIONAL

1) "Sea Sword 2"

- INS Trikand has participated in the Combined Maritime Forces led Operation "Sea Sword 2" in the Northwest Arabian Sea. The operation was held to prevent narcotics trade & stop smuggling entities from using the seas for their nefarious activities. Earlier, the 26th edition of the multinational maritime exercise "MALABAR 22" culminated in Japan on November 15th.
- This edition also marked the 30th anniversary of the exercise and was hosted by the Japan Maritime Self-Defense Force (JMSDF). This effort is part of the Indian Navy's commitment to ensuring the safety of the



























seas and collective security in the region as espoused by the SAGAR vision of the Honourable Prime Minister of India.

2) First Greenfield airport in Arunachal Pradesh

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the first Greenfield airport in Arunachal Pradesh the Donyi Polo Airport at Itanagar — and dedicated the 600 MW Kameng Hydro Power Station to the nation.
- Northeast India will now have 16 airports.



3) Public sector banks

- Government has decided to provide longer tenure to Managing Director and other whole-time directors of the public sector banks.
- Now the appointment can be made initially for up to 5 years, which can be extended for the 5 more years.

4) "The Microsoft"

- India has become LinkedIn's fastest-growing market as more companies and advertisers come online, with sales in the country rising at a 50% year-on-year clip.
- LinkedIn is a "The Microsoft" owned business networking service company.

5) Rajiv Kumar

- Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar has been invited by the Election Commission of Nepal as an international observer for the forthcoming elections to Nepal's House of Representatives and Provincial Assembly, the Election Commission said.

7) Intellectual Property Rights

- Indian Army registered for Intellectual Property Rights of the new design and camouflage pattern uniform to establish the ownership.
- The Controller General of Patents, Designs, and Trademark, Kolkata completed the registration process.



STATE NEWS

1) Elephant death audit framework

- Tamil Nadu's Forest Department has introduced an elephant death audit framework to put in place a more detailed and transparent process for recording and monitoring elephant deaths in the State. - -----Presently, identifying the cause of mortality in the field remains critical for many questions related to population and conservation of elephants.
- The framework will improve transparency, assist all stakeholders in assessing the results and ultimately facilitate standardisation and more credible comparisons of cause of mortality.

2) 'Amar Sarkar'

- Tripura chief minister Dr Manik Saha his government is working to ensure all central and state-sponsored schemes reach every doorstep and launched a new portal, 'Amar Sarkar', to act as a bridge between the people and the government.
- A total of 78 departments, including the panchayat department, has been included in the webportal. The portal will help people to register their problems and complaints through village committee officials.

3) "Silver treasures from Denmark and India"

- Museum Kolding and the National Museum in New Delhi will open the joint exhibition "Silver treasures from Denmark and India" at the beginning of March 2023.
- An MoU of the exhibition was signed and exchanged between the National Museum, New Delhi, India, and the Museum Kolding, Kolding, in New Delhi.

4) Northeast Olympic Games

- Manipur gets the top position in the Northeast Olympic Games for the second consecutive time with 237 medals, including 85 gold, as the second edition of the regional multi-sport event.
- Manipur also won 76 silver and 77 bronze while Assam was a close second with 201 medals including 81 gold, 60 silver, and 60 bronzes in the event competed among the eight states of the country's northeast region from November 10.



APPOINTMENTS AND RESIGNATIONS

1) Shri Bandaru Wilsonbabu

- Indian Foreign Service (2004), Shri Bandaru Wilsonbabu, presently Ambassador of India to the Republic of Madagascar, has been concurrently accredited as the next Ambassador of India to the Union of the Comoros, with residence in Antananarivo. He is expected to take up the assignment shortly. The Comoros is an independent country made up of 3 islands in southeastern Africa.

1) Unchahar ABHYUDAYA

- NTPC's QC Team from Unchahar ABHYUDAYA has won the "GOLD" award in the 47th International Convention on Quality Control Circle (ICQCC-2022). The convention is being held from 15th-18th November in Jakarta.
