## 1) United Kingdom has put forth plans to include India

- In a recent development, the United Kingdom has put forth plans to include India in an expanded list of safe states, which will have significant implications for individuals arriving in the UK illegally from these countries.

# 2) Russia has formally withdrawn from the Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces

- Russia has formally withdrawn from the Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe (CFE), citing NATO's expansion as a barrier to cooperation.
- The move follows Russia's recent revocation of the Comprehensive Nuclear Test Ban Treaty (CTBT) and a test launch of an intercontinental ballistic missile.
