INTERNATIONAL

1) World Investment Report 2023

- Recently, World Investment Report 2023 has been published by United Nations Conference on Trade and Development.
- The report provides valuable insights into foreign direct investment (FDI) trends in developing countries.
- In 2022, FDI in developing countries in Asia reached a total of \$662 billion, representing no change compared to the previous year.

2) Global Peace Index 2023

- The 2023 Global Peace Index is published by the Institute for Economics and Peace. It is the 17th Edition. The report reveals the average level of global peacefulness deteriorated for the ninth consecutive year, with 84 countries recording an improvement and 79 a deterioration.
- Iceland has retained its position as the most peaceful country.
- India's position on the Global Peace Index stands at 126 out of 163 countries.

NATIONAL

1) e-NAM

- The National Agriculture Market (e-NAM) in India is playing an important role in the agricultural sector, connecting farmers and traders across the country.
- It has witnessed remarkable growth since its launch in April 2016. As of July 3, 2023, more than 1.75 crore farmers and 2.45 lakh traders have registered on the e-NAM portal.
- It's main objective is to promote inter-mandi and inter-State trade is to obtain competitive prices for surplus farmer produce.

2) Extended Producers Responsibility

- Indore Municipal Corporation became the first urban body in the country to receive Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR) credit for recycling banned single-use plastic items.
- Indore has implemented a complete ban on single-use plastic items within the city.

3) 7th Edition of Indian Navy – US Navy salvage

- The 7th edition of the Indian Navy US Navy (IN USN) salvage and explosive ordnance disposal exercise, Salvex, was conducted at Kochi.
- The exercise saw participation from both the navies which included the ships INS Nireekshak and USNS Salvor.

4) MoU between Tanzania and IIT Madras

- The memorandum of understanding (MoU) for setting up a campus of IIT Madras in Zanzibar, Tanzania, was signed between the Government of India, IIT Madras, and the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training of Zanzibar, Tanzania.
- The establishment of the IIT campus will enhance India's global reputation, diplomatic relationships, and expand the international footprint of IIT Madras.

5) International Conference on Green Hydrogen

- The three-day International Conference on Green Hydrogen commenced in New Delhi. The conference aims to establish a Green Hydrogen ecosystem and discuss advancements in the green hydrogen value chain.
- The Union Minister for Power Shri R. K. Singh, inaugurated the conference, emphasizing the government's commitment to energy transition and decarbonization through Green Hydrogen.

1) Centralised Information Management System

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has introduced the Centralised Information Management System.
- It's aim is to revolutionize its data handling, analysis, and governance. The system leverages advanced technology to manage big data, enabling powerful data mining, text mining, visual analytics, and statistical analysis.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

1) Cucumber mosaic virus & Tomato mosaic virus

- Tomato farmers of Maharashtra and Karnataka have been facing significant challenges due to the impact of Cucumber mosaic virus (CMV) and Tomato mosaic virus (ToMV).
- These two viruses are primary viruses responsible for the loss of tomato yields. Cucumber mosaic virus (CMV) affects crops in Maharashtra, while Tomato mosaic virus (ToMV) affects crops in Karnataka and other South Indian states.
- Controlling CMV is more challenging due to its wide host range, which includes cucumber, melon, eggplant, tomato, carrot, lettuce, celery, cucurbits, and some ornamentals.

2) Threads - a new social media Platform

- Meta has introduced a new social media platform called Threads. Threads is now accessible in more than 100 countries through the Apple App Store and Google Play Store.
- Threads has been integrated with Instagram, with a strong focus on privacy features. Users have the choice to show or conceal a badge on their Instagram profile, and they can customize privacy settings separately for each app.
