INTERNATIONAL

1) World's first open-access Carbon capture and storage

- Norway is building world's first open-access Carbon capture and storage infrastructure on Norway's North Sea coast.

- It will allow any emitter that has captured his CO2 emissions to deliver that CO2 for safe handling, transport and storage.

NATIONAL

1) India's first dark sky reserve at Hanle

- Department of Science & Technology has announced setting up of India's first dark sky reserve at Hanle in Ladakh as a part of Changthang Wildlife Sanctuary.

- It will promote astronomy-tourism.

- It will be one of the world's highest-located sites for optical, infra-red, and gamma-ray telescopes.

2) Lumpi-ProVacInd vaccine

- Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) aims to commercially launch its indigenously-developed Lumpi-ProVacInd vaccine against Lumpy Skin Disease virus.

- Vaccine has been jointly developed by ICAR's National Research Centre on Equines (NRCE) at Hisar, Haryana and Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI) at Izatnagar, Uttar Pradesh.

3) 5G technology

- Reliance announced it will be deploying Standalone 5G in the country.

- Standalone 5G is an end-to-end 5G network which means that the base station and radio antenna are built from scratch keeping 5G specifications in mind.

4) Inflatable Aerodynamic Decelerator

- ISRO has successfully tested Inflatable Aerodynamic Decelerator technology to land missions on Venus & Mars.

1) Binesh Kumar Tyagi

- The government has appointed Captain Binesh Kumar Tyagi as the new chairman and managing director of Shipping Corporation of India Ltd (SCI).

- The appointment is for five years from the date of assumption of charge of the post, or till the date of his superannuation, or until further orders, whichever is the earliest, according to an office order issued by the Department of Personnel and Training.

2) Mary Elizabeth Truss

Mary Elizabeth Truss, a British politician is now the leader of the Conservative Party and is slated to become prime minister of the UK on September 6, 2022.
Under Prime Ministers Theresa May, Boris Johnson, and David Cameron, she held a number of Cabinet positions.
