INTERNATIONAL

1) Hermit - a new spyware

- Hermit is a new spyware with capability to affect both Android and iOS devices.
- Hermit is a commercial spyware known to be used by governments with victims in Kazakhstan, Italy and northern Syria.

2) Yaogan-35

- Three new remote sensing satellites were successfully launched by China from the Xichang Satellite Launch Centre in the Sichuan Province in southwest China.
- The satellites were launched by a Long March-2D carrier rocket at 10:22 a.m. (local time) as part of the Yaogan-35 family and successfully entered the intended orbit.

NATIONAL

1) Norms to protect kids working in OTT platforms

- National Commission for the Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) has published draft guidelines to safeguard children in movies, TV shows, social media, OTT platforms etc. from physical and psychological stress.
- Producers must get a district magistrate's approval before including a child in a shoot.

2) 5G Radio Access Network

- Centre for Development of Telematics (C-DOT) and Galore Networks have signed an agreement for collaborative development of end-to-end 5G RAN products & solutions.
- C-DOT was established in 1984 as an autonomous Telecom R&D centre of Department of Telecom.

3) Kayamkulam floating solar PV project

- NTPC has commissioned the floating solar PV Project at Kayamkulam, Kerala.
- Floating Solar Photovoltaic Plants is an alternative to conventional ground mounted PV systems. It uses PV modules which float on the surface of water bodies such as drinking water reservoirs, quarry lakes, irrigation canals etc.

1) Card Tokenisation

- RBI extended deadline for card data storage and tokenisation implementation to September 30, 2022.
- Tokenisation refers to replacement of actual card details with an alternate code called the token, which shall be unique for a combination of card, token requestor and device.
