INTERNATIONAL

- 1) "Poverty has declined over the last decade But Not As Much As Previously Thought"
- "Poverty has declined over the last decade But Not As Much As Previously Thought", is the World Bank working paper, aims to encourage exchange of ideas on development, and quickly disseminates the findings of research in progress.
- As per the report, Poverty headcount fell from 22.5% in 2011 to 10.2% in 2019.

NATIONAL

1) "Hunar Haat"

- Union minister Anurag Thakur inaugurated the 40th edition of "Hunar Haat," a forum to preserve, protect, and promote local artists and craftsmen.
- "Hunar Haat" has offered employment to over 9 lakh artists and craftsmen in just six years, in addition to promoting ancestral arts and crafts even in distant corners of the country.

2) "Radio Aksh"

- 'Radio Aksh', India's first-ever radio channel for the visually impaired has been launched in Nagpur, Maharashtra.
- It was the idea of "The Blind Relief Association Nagpur" (TBRAN) and "Samdrushti Kshamata Vikas Avam Anusandhan Mandal" (Saksham).

3) "Innovation (General) – Central"

- UDAN (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik), the Regional Connectivity scheme of the Ministry of Civil Aviation has been selected for Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Public Administration 2020 under the category "Innovation (General) - Central".
- It emphasizes on Good Governance, Qualitative achievements, and last mile connectivity rather than only on achievement of quantitative targets.
- The award was launched by the Government of India in 2006. The award comes with a trophy, scroll and an incentive of Rs 10 lakhs.
