INTERNATIONAL

1) Artemis Accords

- France is set to sign a U.S.-led multilateral agreement called the Artemis Accords.
- The program aims to return humans to the moon's surface by 2025.
- The United Kingdom, Japan, and Canada have signed the accords, with France set to become the 7th European state.

NATIONAL

1) National Tribal Research Institute

- The Union Home Minster inaugurated the National Tribal Research Institute in New Delhi.
- It will work as a premier national level institute and nerve-centre of tribal concerns, issues and matters in academic, executive and legislative fields.

2) Grand Challenges India

- The Department of Biotechnology and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation have renewed the Memorandum of Understanding for Grand Challenges India originally signed in 2012.
- It intends to boost innovation and research to develop affordable and sustainable solutions to improve health, in India.

3) Geospatial Self Certification Portal

- Department of Science and Technology launched the Self Certification Portal for the Geospatial Data and Maps for India.
- It is developed in collaboration with National Informatics Centre.

4) Environment Performance Index

- Environment Performance Index is a biennial index, was started in 2002 as Environmental Sustainability Index.
- It is Prepared by World Economic Forum in collaboration with Yale Center for Environmental Law and Policy and Columbia University Center for International Earth Science Information Network.
- India ranked at 180th with a score of 18.9 in EPI 2022.

- The app aims to benefit tourists and the institutions working in the beach tourism sector in a holistic management of beaches.

4) Naan Mudhalvan (I am the first)

- The Tamil Nadu government launched Naan Mudhalvan (I am the first). Under this programme, Tamil Nadu government has now launched Nalaya Thiran (Tomorrow's ability).
- In this programme, 50,000 college students will train with the knowledge in computer science, electronics and IT domains, skilling them on problem solving using technologies.
