NATIONAL

1) Rural Self Employment Training Institutes

It is an initiative of Ministry of Rural Development (MORD). It's objective is to have dedicated infrastructure in each district of the country to impart training and skill upgradation of rural youth geared towards entrepreneurship development. They are managed by banks with active co-operation from the Government of India and State Governments.

2) SKOCH State of Governance rankings

Andhra Pradesh has retained its number one spot in the SKOCH State of Governance rankings for the second consecutive year. The second rank was bagged by West Bengal and Odisha was ranked 3, Gujarat was ranked 4 and Maharashtra was ranked 5. Neighbouring Telangana was ranked 6.

3) Virtual Smart Grid Knowledge Center

Union Minister for Power R.K. Singh launched the Virtual Smart Grid Knowledge Center (SGKC) and Innovation Park. It allows for a digital footprint of the real SGKC, which was needed during the COVID-19 epidemic.

1) 'Women@Work' program

The government of Karnataka has launched 'Women@Work' program to provide five lakh jobs within 2026 to women with necessary employable skills. The program aims to focus on the efforts of corporate programs on attracting women workforce.

2) 'Sushma Swaraj Award' for women

Haryana Chief Minister, Manohar Lal Khattar, while presenting the state budget, has announced a 'Sushma Swaraj Award' for women for their significant achievements or contribution in different walks of life in the international and national spheres. The Sushma Swaraj Award will carry an award money of Rs 5 lakh along with a commendation.

APPOINTMENTS AND RESIGNATIONS

1) Yoon Suk-yeol

Yoon Suk-yeol has been declared as the winner of the 2022 South Korean presidential election to be elected as the new President of the country. He is scheduled to assume office as president on May 10, 2022, for a fixed term of five years. Yoon Suk-yeol will succeed incumbent President Moon Jae-in.
