INTERNATIONAL

1) "RS- 28 SARMAT"

- Vladimir Putin, Russian President announced that his military had successfully test-fired an intercontinental ballistic missile, "RS- 28 SARMAT" capable of carrying a big nuclear payload.
- It is a super-heavy, thermonuclear-armed intercontinental-range ballistic missile.
- The Sarmat was supposed to take the place of the Soviet-built Voevoda.
- NATO dubbed "RS- 28 SARMAT" as "Satan 2".

NATIONAL

1) NITI Aayog and UNICEF India has signed a SoI on the SDGs

- NITI Aayog and UNICEF India has signed a Statement of Intent (SoI) on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) with a focus on children.
- It seeks to formalize a framework to launch the first report on 'State of India's Children: Status and Trends in Multidimensional Child Development'.
- It will help in understanding the multidimensional attainments and deprivations among children.

2) Bioenergy and Biofuels

- India and Brazil agreed to strengthen the bilateral cooperation in bioenergy and develop an Indian-Brazil Alliance for Bioenergy and Biofuels.
- Bioenergy is a form of renewable energy that is derived from recently living organic materials known as biomass.
- When biomass is converted into liquid or gaseous fuels such as ethanol, methanol, methane and hydrogen, it is known as biofuels.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) Legal Entity Identifier

- RBI has extended the guidelines on Legal Entity Identifier to large borrowers of NBFCs and Primary (Urban) Co-operative Banks (UCBs).
- LEI is a 20-character alphanumeric code which is used to create a global reference data system that uniquely identifies every legal entity in any jurisdiction that is party to a financial transaction.
- It improves the quality and accuracy of financial data reporting systems for better risk management.

AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS

1) Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration

- These awards are given by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances on Civil Services Day (21st April).
- These awards were instituted in 2006. In 2022, 16 awards were given for 5 identified priority programmes like:
- a. Seamless, End-to-End Delivery of Services without Human Intervention.
- b. Promoting People's Participation in Poshan Abhiyan
