INTERNATIONAL

1) 5th BIMSTEC Summit

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has participated in the 5th Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC) Summit through virtual mode. The Summit was hosted by the Government of Sri Lanka, which was the chair nation of BIMSTEC. Theme: "Towards a Resilient Region, Prosperous Economies, Healthy People".

2) World Energy transition Outlook 2022

World Energy transition Outlook 2022 was launched by the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) at the Berlin Energy Transition Dialogue. Energy Transition is a pathway toward transformation of the global energy sector from fossil-based to zero-carbon by the second half of this century.

NATIONAL

1) Indian Ocean Naval Symposium Maritime Exercise 2022

The first edition of the Indian Ocean Naval Symposium Maritime Exercise 2022 (IMEX-22) was held in Goa and in the Arabian Sea. The objective of the exercise was to enhance the interoperability of the navies of member nations in Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief operations.

2) "Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain campaign 2022"

President of India launched the "Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain campaign 2022" in New Delhi. It's objective is to nudge the states and stake-holders to create appropriate Rain Water Harvesting Structures (RWHS) suitable to the climatic conditions and sub-soil strata before monsoon.

'Jingkieng Jri or Living Root Bridge', found in Meghalaya highlighting the socio-cultural, social and botanical links between people and nature, has been included in the tentative list of World Heritage Sites of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation.
