INTERNATIONAL

1) Social Security Agreement

- India and Argentina have signed a significant Social Security Agreement aimed at protecting the rights of professionals and workers from both countries regarding social security contributions.
- It establishes a legal framework for regulating the insurance period (period of services with contributions) and contributory benefits for detached workers, including crew members of airlines and ships.

2) Indonesia launches "Whoosh" high-speed railway

- Indonesian President Joko Widodo officially inaugurated Southeast Asia's first high-speed railway.
- The ambitious project, known as the "Whoosh" high-speed railway, is a key component of China's Belt and Road Initiative

NATIONAL

1) 11th edition of joint military exercise - SAMPRITI

- India and Bangladesh started the 11th edition of their annual joint military exercise, SAMPRITI in Umroi, Meghalaya.
- SAMPRITI, initiated in 2009, aims to boost interoperability, share tactical expertise, and promote best practices between the Indian and Bangladeshi armies.

2) "Statue of Equality"

The "Statue of Equality," touted as the largest statue of Dr. B R Ambedkar outside India, is set to be unveiled in Maryland.

1) Nobel Prize in Physics for 2023

- The Nobel Prize in Physics for 2023 has been awarded to Ferenc Krausz, Pierre Agostini, and Anne L'Huillier for their groundbreaking experiments that have led to the "creation of attosecond pulses of light".
- Pierre Agostini is a French-American experimental physicist who currently teaches at The Ohio State University, Columbus, US.
- Anne L'Huillier, a physicist born in Paris in 1958, teaches at Lund University in Sweden.
- Ferenc Krausz, born in Hungary in 1962, serves as the director at the Max Planck Institute of Quantum Optics in Germany and teaches at Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München.

2) Global Indian Award

- Renowned author, philanthropist Sudha Murthy, was honored with the prestigious Global Indian Award by the Canada India Foundation at a grand Indo-Canadian gala in Toronto.
- The award, which carries a value of \$50,000.

1) Khaled Khalifa

SPORTS

1) 2023 Asian Games

2) SAFF Under-19 Championship

- India won the South Asian Football Federation (SAFF) Under-19 Championship after defeating Pakistan 3-0 in a dominating display in the finals at the Dashrath Rangasala Stadium in Kathmandu, Nepal.
- It was India's eighth youth title in the SAFF championships.

3) Ajay Jadeja

The Afghanistan Cricket Board appointed former India captain Ajay Jadeja as the team mentor for the upcoming ODI World Cup.
