- Referring to the first paragraph of the passage we can 1.(4) infer that sentence (a) and (c) are correct. As the six villagers were blind so they were touching the different features of elephant.
- 2.(3) Refer the first few lines of second paragraph of the passage "They began to argue about what the elephant was like, and each of them insisted that he was right."
- 3. (3) Refer the second paragraph of the passage "The reason that each of you experienced it differently is because you touched a different part of the elephant".
- 4. (4) Refer the last paragraph of the passage. "we should learn to accept the opinion of the other person rather than arguing" is the correct explanation.
- 5. (5) 'The elephant' is the most appropriate title of the passage as the whole passage revolves around the elephant.
- 6. (3) All parts of elephant are mentioned in the passage except the eyes.
- 7.(2) Perspective means a particular attitude towards or way of regarding something; a point of view. Hence it has same meaning as stance.

Concord means agreement or harmony between people or groups.

Rebuke means scold.

Rife means widespread.

- 8. (4) Insisted means demand something forcefully, not accepting refusal. Hence it has same meaning as asserted. Scrupulous means careful. Reproach means express to (someone) one's disapproval of or disappointment in their actions. Inundate means overwhelm.
- 9. (5) Argue means give reasons or cite evidence in support of an idea, action, or theory, typically with the aim of persuading others to share one's view. Hence it has opposite meaning as concur. Upbraid means scold. Extol means praise.
- Moral means a lesson that can be derived from a story or experience. Hence it has opposite meaning as unethical. Quibble means a slight objection or criticism.
  - Condemn means express complete disapproval of, censure.
- 'affected, scale' is the correct use.

Affected- influenced or touched by an external factor.

- 12.(1) 'conscious, keep' is the correct use. Conscious- aware of and responding to one's surroundings.
- 'argued, control' is the correct use. 13. (5)
- 14. (3) 'spanning, adieu' is the correct use.
  - Spanning- extend across (a period of time or a range of subjects).

Adieu-goodbye.

- 15.(2) 'With, garrisoned' is the correct use.
  - Garrisoned-provide (a place) with a group of troops. 'would have taken' will be used in place of 'would take'
- 16. (4) as 'had+ subject+ V3... subject+ would+ have+ V3' is used. (III) is also correct in the same way.

Ex. Had he worked hard, he would have succeeded.

- 'had we' will be used in place of 'we had' as verb is used before the subject with 'scarcely' or 'hardly'. (I) and (II) both are correct.
  - No sooner takes 'than' with it but in the given statement 'when' is used. Therefore (III) is incorrect.
- 'make' will be used in place of 'makes' as the subject of 18.(4) the sentence 'perquisites' is plural. Therefore (III) is correct.

(II) is also correct.

- Only (III) is correct. 'as' will be used in place of 'that' as 19.(2) relative pronoun, because relative pronoun is used in the form of 'as' after 'such'.
  - Ex. He is such a good man as can help you.
- 20. (2) Pronoun 'it' will be used in the form of object after 'making' for 'book'.
- 21.(1) 'aware' is the appropriate word for the blank as the paragraph talks about meditation which is being conscious of performing action through divinity.
- 22.(2) 'action' best suits the purpose as it is also used in above sentence.
- 23.(1) 'performing' best suits the purpose. Contrive means create or bring about (an object or a situation) by deliberate use of skill and artifice.
- 24. (4) 'respect' is the most appropriate word.

Perversity means a deliberate desire to behave in an unreasonable or unacceptable way.

- 28. (2) 'studied' is the most appropriate word.




