INTERNATIONAL

1) India becomes 68th country to Join Interpol's international child sexual exploitation database

- India has joined Interpol's international child sexual exploitation database which will allow it to draw links between victims, abusers, and crime scenes using audiovisual data.

- The CBI, which is India's nodal agency for Interpol matters, joined the database making India the 68th country to connect to it, according to a statement from Interpol.

2) World Population Prospects 2022

- World Population Prospects 2022 is released by United Nations Department of Economic and Social affairs.

- The report provides data and analysis of population trends and development outcomes for all countries and areas of the world.

- As per the report, India will overtake China as most populous country in 2023 and is likely to retain top spot till 2100.

NATIONAL

1) 6th National Conclave on Mines & Minerals

- The 6th National Conclave on Mines & Minerals was held as part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav legendary week celebrations in New Delhi.

- Shri Amit Shah was the chief guest. The one-day conclave was officially opened by Union Minister of Mines, Coal, and Parliamentary Affairs Shri Pralhad Joshi.

2) India's longest double decker bridge in Nagpur

- The National Highways Authority of India and Maharashtra Metro achieved the world record for constructing the longest double-decker viaduct with a length of 3.14 km in Nagpur.

- The longest viaduct with highway flyover and metro rail supported on single column piers.

- National Emblem is an adaptation of Lion Capital of Asoka at Sarnath. It was adopted on January 26, 1950.

- Motto Satyameva Jayate means 'Truth Alone Triumphs, written in Devanagari script.

4) 'AI in Defence'

- Ministry of Defence launched 75 newly-developed Al products/technologies during the first-ever 'AI in Defence' (AIDef) symposium.

- Products include robotic mine detector, intrusion detection system, sensors for under water domain awareness, Mandarin translation device etc.

5) Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis

- Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis is a strain of bacteria (developed by ICMR) that kills mosquito and black fly larvae without harming other animals.

- When ingested by mosquito larvae, the bacterial toxins destroy their gut within 10-30 minutes upon ingestion.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) Deutsche Bahn- world's first Intermodal Partner of Star Alliance

- Deutsche Bahn (DB) will be the world's first Intermodal Partner of Star Alliance. With this, DB and the aviation industry are sending another strong signal for the environment-friendly evolution of the travel industry.

- Germany is the first market and DB is the world's first partner in the new Star Alliance initiative.
