1) National Flag Adoption Day

- National Flag Adoption Day is celebrated on July 22. The day is observed to celebrate the Constituent Assembly's adoption of flag in 1947.
- The flag should be rectangular in shape and length-to-width ratio should always be 3:2.

2) Amrit Bharat Station Scheme

- Amrit Bharat Station Scheme was launched by the Ministry of railways to modernize railway stations for the development of stations on a continuous basis with a long-term approach.
- 1309 Railway Stations have been identified under Amrit Bharat Station Scheme for their development.
- It involves preparation of Master Plans and their implementation in phases to improve the amenities at the stations.

3) Electronic Cigarettes

- Ministry of Health and Family welfare launched an online portal for reporting of violations under Prohibition of Electronic Cigarettes Act.
- E-cigarettes are battery-operated systems that heat a substance (liquid or solid), which contains nicotine and often flavours, to create an aerosol for inhalation.
- E-cigarettes' aerosols have harmful substances such as nicotine, cancer-causing chemicals, heavy metals such as nickel, tin and lead, chemicals causing lung diseases such as diacetyl.





4) Heat Index

- The India Meteorological Department has introduced the Heat Index on an experimental basis.
- It is designed to offer general guidance for regions in India where the apparent temperature, also known as the "feel-like" temperature, is higher due to a combination of heat and humidity, causing discomfort for people.

5) India Climate Energy Dashboard

- NITI Aayog has launched the India Climate Energy Dashboard 3.0, a comprehensive platform providing near real-time data on the energy sector, climate, and related economic datasets sourced from government publications.
- The platform allows free access and analysis of datasets using an analytical engine, enabling users to gain insights and better understand the energy and climate sectors.

6) Second edition of "G20 THINQ"

- The second edition of "G20 THINQ" has been launched by the Indian Navy and the Navy Welfare and Wellness Association.
- It's main aim is to unite youth from diverse regions and geographies, fostering lasting friendships with the spirit of 'Vasudaiva Kutumbakam' World is One Family.
