National Gallery of Modern Art launches Audio-Visual Guide app

- National Gallery of Modern Art (NGMA) virtually launched an Audio-Visual Guide app on International Museum Day (18 May).
- This app will make it possible for museum viewers to listen to stories and anecdotes on their smartphones of several treasured Indian Modern artworks displayed at the museum anywhere at any time.

Haryana becomes the first state to allow reimbursement of GST on 'COVID items' donations

Haryana became the first state in India to allow reimbursement of goods and service tax paid by companies, non-governmental organisations and individuals on purchase of 15 items including COVID-19 vaccines, Remdesivir injections, ventilators and oxygen cylinders that they have donated free of cost to the state government or state-run hospitals.

Indian hockey team goalkeeper PR Sreejesh was appointed as a member of the FIH Athletes' Committee

- India hockey team goalkeeper PR Sreejesh was appointed as a member of the FIH (International Hockey Federation) Athletes' Committee during the virtual meeting of the world body's Executive Board.
- The board also approved the appointment of Steve Horgan (USA) as the new chair of the FIH Rules **Committee**, succeeding David Collier (England). He has led the Indian team in the past and was one of the four new members appointed by the Executive Board, which met two days before the 47th FIH Congress.

World Metrology Day – 20 May
