1) "Ayushman Bhav"

- The Union health ministry is preparing to introduce a comprehensive health initiative named "Ayushman Bhav".
- It's main aim is to ensure effective implementation of all state-run health schemes to reach each intended recipient. The activities under the scheme includes:
- a. Avushman Apke Dwar 3.0 aims to ensure full saturation of health schemes, leaving no eligible beneficiary deprived of essential benefits.
- b. Ayushman Sabha will be spearheaded by the village health, sanitation, and nutrition committee
- c. Ayushman Mela will involve organizing medical camps and facilitating early diagnosis through screenings.
- d. Ayushman Gram, aims to achieve 100% coverage of PMJAY card distribution, ABHA ID generation, immunization, and screening for non-communicable diseases.

2) 'Semicon India 2023'

- 'Semicon India 2023' is set to be held in Gandhinagar on July 28. It aims to bring together leading companies, policymakers, and industry stalwarts to showcase India's remarkable progress in the semiconductor sector.

1) World swimming championships

- 2023 world swimming championships took place in Japan. 21-year-old Leon Marchand achieved a remarkable feat, shattering legendary American swimmer Michael Phelps' final individual world record in the 400m Individual Medley.
- Leon Marchand secured a stunning time of 4 minutes and 2.50 seconds in the 400m IM, setting a new world record. This outstanding performance surpassed Phelps' previous record of 4:03.84, which had remained unbeaten since the 2008 Beijing Olympics.
