## 1) Central Vista Oversight Committee

The union government formed a five-member Central Vista Oversight Committee, which was headed by former Finance Secretary Ratan P Watal, to ensure faster delivery of projects being executed under the Central Vista redevelopment plan.

#### 2) WISER programme

Indo-German Science and Technology Centre has launched the 1st of its kind program – Women's Involvement in Science and Engineering Research (WISER) programme, for encouraging women researchers participation in joint Research and Development projects.

## 3) Kuno National Park

The Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh is set to get 13 cheetahs next year. The Kuno National Park was originally developed as the second home for Asiatic lions in India, apart from Gir National Park.

## 4) 6th edition of the BRICS Film Festival awards

6th edition of the BRICS Film Festival awards was announced at the 52nd International Film Festival of India in Goa. Best film Award was shared by South African Film "Barakat" and Russian Film "The Sun above me Never Sets".

#### 1) Drone AquilaX2

Meghalaya launched a pilot of India's 1st Medicine Delivery via e-VTOL (Virtual take off and landing ) Drone AquilaX2. The drone delivers medicines to remote primary health centers.

#### 2) Project STREET

Kerala Tourism, Department of Tourism, Kerala launches the project STREET, to promote and take tourism deep into the interiors and rural hinterland of Kerala. STREET is an acronym for Sustainable, Tangible, Responsible, Experiential, Ethnic, Tourism hubs.
