British Author Samantha Harvey Wins 2024 Booker Prize for Novel 'Orbital'

- British author Samantha Harvey has been awarded the 2024 Booker Prize for her novel *Orbital*, marking the first space-themed book to receive the honor.

Key Details:

- *Orbital* explores themes from the perspective of astronauts aboard the International Space Station.
- It has become the best-selling book on the 2024 Booker shortlist in the UK, surpassing sales of the previous three Booker winners combined.
- Harvey is the first woman since 2019 to receive the Booker Prize and will be awarded 50,000 pounds.

Significance:

- She dedicated the award to advocates for Earth and peace.
- The announcement was made at London's Old Billingsgate.
- Objective: The prize highlights significant literary contributions and innovative narratives in contemporary literature.

Indian Navy to Conduct 4th Coastal Defence Exercise 'Sea-Vigil-24'

- The Indian Navy is set to hold the 4th edition of the Coastal Defence Exercise 'Sea-Vigil-24' to enhance national coastal security.

Key Details:

- The two-day exercise will involve six ministries and 21 organizations and agencies.
- Focus areas include the security of coastal assets like ports, oil rigs, moorings, cable landing points, and critical coastal infrastructure.
- For the first time, the Indian Army and Air Force will also participate in this exercise.

Significance:

- Sea-Vigil was first conceptualized in 2018 to validate and strengthen coastal defence measures.
- Objective: The exercise aims to test and improve India's coastal defence readiness and response capabilities.

India Defeats South Korea in Women's Asian Hockey Champions Trophy

- India secured a victory against South Korea in the Women's Asian Hockey Champions Trophy at Rajgir Hockey Stadium, Bihar.
- Deepika Sehrawat scored the winning goal through a penalty stroke, marking her second goal of the match.
- Sangita Kumari opened India's scoring in the 3rd minute, while Korea's Yuri Lee and Eunbi Cheon scored in the 34th and 38th minutes.
- India previously defeated Malaysia 4-0 in their opening match.
- India ranks second in the points table with six points, behind China, who leads with a higher goal difference.

CCPA Imposes Rs 54.6 Lakh Fine on Coaching Centres, Issues New Guidelines to Curb Misleading Ads

- The Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) has imposed a penalty of Rs 54.6 lakh on 18 coaching institutes for misleading advertisements and issued new guidelines to prevent malpractices in the coaching sector.

Key Details:

- The new guidelines, titled Guidelines for Prevention of Misleading Advertisement in the Coaching Sector, 2024, aim to protect students from deceptive marketing practices.
- Coaching centres are prohibited from making false claims about course offerings, duration, faculty, fees, refund policies, selection rates, job promises, and assured admissions.
- Coaching centres must obtain written consent from students before using their names or photos in advertisements, and any such endorsements must be from students who have succeeded in the course.

Mexican General Appointed Head of UN Observer Group in Kashmir

- UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres has appointed Mexican Major General Ramon Guardado Sanchez as the new head of the UN Military Observer Group in India and Pakistan (UNMOGIP).

Key Details:

- Guardado will succeed Argentine Rear Admiral Guillermo Rios as the Head of Mission and Chief Military Observer for UNMOGIP.
- UNMOGIP was established by the Security Council in 1949 to monitor the ceasefire between India and Pakistan along the Line of Control.
- The mission has a staff of 110, including 44 military personnel from about 10 countries, and its headquarters alternate between Srinagar and Islamabad.

Significance:

- Guardado previously served as the Commissioner of the National Guard in Yucatan and as the Liaison to Congress for Mexico's National Defence Joint Staff.
- He has experience with the UN, having served as a regional chief observer for the Verification Mission in Colombia and as the Commanding Officer of Mexico's Peace Operations Joint Training Centre.

South Korea Signs MOU with Poland on Financial Cooperation

- South Korea and Poland have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to enhance financial cooperation, focusing on expanding South Korean banks' presence in Poland and funding for South Korean firms operating in the country.

Key Details:

- The MOU was signed in Seoul by South Korea's Financial Services Commission (FSC) chief Kim Byoung-hwan and Poland's financial watchdog (KNF) head Jacek Jastrzebski.
- The agreement aims to expand cooperation beyond banking to sectors like insurance.
- As of the end of 2023, 370 South Korean firms were operating in Poland, with \$6 billion in accumulated investments.
- Poland is South Korea's largest trading partner in Central and Eastern Europe, with bilateral trade reaching a record \$10.1 billion last year.

S. Korea, US, Japan to Conduct 2nd Trilateral Freedom Edge Exercise

- South Korea, the United States, and Japan are set to conduct their second trilateral multi-domain exercise, known as "Freedom Edge," to strengthen joint deterrence against North Korea's threats, particularly in light of its growing ties with Russia.

Key Details:

- The three-day exercise will take place in international waters south of South Korea's Jeju Island, four months after the inaugural exercise.
- The exercise will involve various warships and aircraft, including the U.S. Navy's USS George Washington aircraft carrier and F-35 stealth fighters, South Korea's ROKS Seoae Ryu Seong-ryong destroyer, and Japan's JS Haguro destroyer.
- The exercise will cover areas such as air defense, ballistic missile defense, anti-submarine warfare, maritime interdiction, and defensive cyber training.

Significance:

- The exercise reflects a joint effort by the three nations to counter North Korea's missile and nuclear threats, following North Korea's recent test of an intercontinental ballistic missile (ICBM).

Trump Nominates Key Cabinet Members After 2024 Presidential Victory

- Following his victory in the 2024 U.S. Presidential Election, President-elect Donald Trump has nominated key individuals for prominent roles in his administration.

Key Appointments:

- **Attorney General:** Congressman Matt Gaetz has been nominated to be the Attorney General of the United States. Trump emphasized Gaetz's commitment to ending partisan influence in the justice system, strengthening borders, and restoring public trust in the Department of Justice.
- **Secretary of State:** Senator Marco Rubio of Florida has been selected as the Secretary of State. Rubio expressed his commitment to executing Trump's foreign policy agenda, focusing on "peace through strength" and prioritizing American interests.
- **Director of National Intelligence (DNI):** Former Congresswoman and Lieutenant Colonel Tulsi Gabbard has been appointed DNI. Trump praised Gabbard for her decades of service, highlighting her bipartisan appeal and commitment to securing American freedoms.
