1) "Strengthening Multilateral Development Banks: The Triple Agenda" report

- The report was published by an Independent Expert Group (IEG) that was commissioned by the Indian G20 Presidency. The report recommended that:
- a. Adopting a triple mandate of eliminating extreme poverty, boosting shared prosperity, and contributing to global public goods
- b. Tripling sustainable lending levels by 2030
- c. Creating a third funding mechanism which would permit flexible and innovative arrangements.
- An Multilateral Development Banks is an international financial institution consisting of member nations from developed and developing countries.

2) "Facilitating Investment in the Sustainable Development Goals"

- The report titled "Facilitating Investment in the Sustainable Development Goals" was published by United Nations Conference on Trade and Development.
- The report provides provides practical advice and case studies of best policy practices for attracting FDI that contribute to sustainable development.
