NATIONAL

1) "Neeraj Chopra Stadium"

Raksha Mantri Renamed the Army Sports Institute stadium as "Neeraj Chopra Stadium". The focus of the Indian Army is to identify and train promising sportspersons in 11 disciplines. The Indian Army's "Mission Olympics" programme was launched in 2001 with the intent to deliver medal-winning performances in the Olympics and other international events.

2) World's highest movie theatre

The world's highest movie theatre has recently been inaugurated in Ladakh, which got its firstever mobile digital movie theatre in the Paldan area of Leh, at an altitude of 11,562 feet. The inflatable theatre can operate in -28 degrees Celcius.

3) Centenary celebrations of the first use of BCG

The centenary celebrations of the first use of BCG (Bacillus Calmette-Guerin), the vaccine against tuberculosis (TB) in humans. TB is caused by a bacterium called Mycobacterium tuberculosis, belonging to the Mycobacteriaceae family consisting of about 200 members. BCG was developed by two Frenchmen, Albert Calmette and Camille Guerin.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) Indo-Nepal Remittance Facility Scheme

The Reserve Bank of India has increased the limit of fund transfer under the Indo-Nepal Remittance Facility Scheme from Rs 50,000 per transaction to Rs 2 lakh per transaction. Earlier there was a ceiling limit of 12 transactions in a year. Now, this limit has also been removed.

SPORTS

1) Avani Lekhara

Shooter Avani Lekhara has won India's first gold medal in 2020 Tokyo Paralympics. Avani Lekhara won medal in women's 10m Air Rifle Standing (SH1) event. She is a 19-year-old Lekhara and created a record at Paralympics by equalling the world record of Ukraine's Iryna Shchetnik.

2) 2021 Barcelona Open chess tournament title

Indian Grandmaster S P Sethuraman has won the 2021 Barcelona Open chess tournament title, remaining unbeaten through the nine rounds, winning six matches and drawing three. Chennaiborn Sethuraman collected 7.5 points after the ninth and final round to tie the score with Daniil Yuffa of Russia.

3) Tokyo Paralympics 2020

India's Nishad Kumar has clinched a silver medal in the men's high jump T47 event at the Tokyo
